Examples include publications which help to expand the laboratory animal knowledge base, contributions to improved quality of animals used in medical research, development of special techniques to enhance lab animal care, promotion of improved standards of laboratory animal care and research through training, and involvement in public education/outreach to promote the truth about lab animal care and research.
